- Any costs that were paid by W&M by credit card at the time of notification of cancellation (often times hotel rooms, train tickets, and tickets for events and other excursions). These costs are often not refundable or transferable.
- Any costs paid on their behalf via invoice that cannot be recouped
- Teaching salary for 1 credit pre-course

Student cancels after deposit deadline, and after 1 credit course is completed, but before program starts

Student will not be refunded:

- Program non-refundable deposit
- Any costs that were paid by W&M by credit card at the time of notification of cancellation (often times hotel rooms, train tickets, and tickets for events and other excursions). These costs are often not refundable or transferable.
- Any costs paid on their behalf via invoice that cannot be recouped
- Teaching salary for 1 credit pre-course
- Student portion of W&M faculty housing, and airfare. These costs are often paid well in advance of the program departure date, and are not recoupable.

Student cancels after program start

No refunds given.

Only in instances when a student is not accepted will the application fee be refunded. Please note the further along in the timeline, the less likely the GEO will be able to recoup costs. Students must notify their GEO Advisor by email if they are withdrawing from the program after the deposit has been paid.
